

Privacy policy for registration for the IP Days 2024

This information pursuant to Art. 13 et seq. GDPR on data protection serve the duty to inform when collecting personal data in connection with registrations for events.

1. Name and contact details of the data controller

3. The purposes for which the personal data are to be processed and the legal basis for the processing

We process your personal data to register for and organise IP Days 2024. We need your data in particular to contact you to confirm your participation and for subsequent participation. For this purpose, we process the following personal data that you provide to us during the registration process

· Personal details (title, first and last name, company, address, e-mail address and telephone number)

If you register as an employee of a company or institution, we process your personal data in accordance with Art. 6 para. 1 lit. b GDPR.

If you register as a natural person, the processing is based on our legitimate interest in accordance with Art. 6 para. 1 lit. f GDPR. A balancing of interests was carried out and came to the conclusion that the processing is necessary to safeguard our legitimate interests and that these outweigh your interests, fundamental rights and freedoms that require the protection of personal data.

4. Obligation to provide personal data

The provision of personal data under point 3 is required for participation in the event. Failure to provide this data would mean that participation is not possible.

5. Automated decision-making including profiling

Meissner Bolte does not make automated decisions in individual cases, including profiling in accordance with Art. 22 (1) and (4) GDPR.

6. Data transfer to a third country

Data transfers to countries outside the EU and the European Economic Area ("third countries") are only carried out on the basis of a data transfer agreement:

- an adequacy decision of the European Commission within the meaning of Art. 45 GDPR.
- an approved certification mechanism pursuant to Art. 42 GDPR together with legally binding and enforceable obligations of the controller or processor in the third country.
- of standard data protection clauses adopted by the Commission in accordance with the review procedure under Art. 93 (2) GDPR.

Data is currently transferred to countries outside the EU and the European Economic Area ("third countries") in connection with the registration and organisation of IP Days 2024 in the following cases:

• Transmission of data to Meissner Bolte UK.

Data is not transferred to other countries outside the European Union or the EEA.



7. Recipients of data and data sources

7.1 Categories of recipients of data

Personal data may be transmitted to the following categories of recipients:

- · Public bodies, due to legal regulations
- · Affiliated companies for the purpose of contract fulfilment or our legitimate interest
- Other third parties in the course of the transfer of functions

In addition, we will only pass on your personal data to third parties if you have given your express prior consent. You have the right to revoke your consent at any time with effect for the future.

Your data will also be passed on if we are legally obliged to do so.

7.2 Data sources

We process personal data that we have received from you as part of the registration process or during the event. Insofar as it is necessary for the provision of our services, we process personal data that we legitimately obtain from publicly accessible sources or are legitimately transmitted by other third parties.

8. Storage duration and criteria for determining the duration

Personal data will only be stored for as long as is necessary to fulfil the purposes stated here or for the retention periods stipulated by law. Once the respective purpose has ceased to apply or the retention periods have expired, the data will be deleted in accordance with the statutory provisions.

In this case, the data will be deleted in accordance with data protection regulations 12 months after the end of the event, unless statutory retention obligations apply.

9. Safety

We take the technical and organisational measures required by law to protect personal data from loss, destruction, manipulation and unauthorised access.

10. Information on your rights as a data subject

Meissner Bolte is responsible for the processing of your data, unless otherwise stated.

You can have access right from us at any time (Art. 15 GDPR) about the data stored about you and its rectification (Art. 16 GDPR) in the event of errors. You can also request the restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR), the portability (Art. 20 GDPR) of the data you have provided to us in a machine-readable format or the erasure of your data (Art. 17 GDPR) - insofar as it is no longer required.

You also have the right to object at any time to the use of your data based on public or legitimate interests (Art. 21 GDPR).

If we process your data on the basis of your consent, you can revoke this consent at any time with effect for the future (Art. 7 para. 3 GDPR). Upon receipt of your revocation, we will no longer process your data for the purposes specified in the consent.
